APPLYING FOR UNIVERSITY FOR SEPTEMBER 2017? The following information is for YOU!



- Once you have picked up and signed for your pin number from OUAC (Ontario Universities Application Centre), you may begin to apply to university!
- JANUARY 11, 2017 DEADLINE for you to submit the ONLINE APPLICATION and all applicable FEES to OUAC (\$150 for 3 program choices, \$50 for each additional choice).
 MGCI recommends that you have your application submitted by December 23, 2016.
 Payment can be made using a credit card online (this form of payment is best because your application is processed immediately). However, you can also use online or telephone banking at selected banks or you can mail in a payment by certified cheque or money order.

OUAC will not process your application until payment is received!!

- <u>FEBRUARY 3, 2017</u> Recommended LAST DATE TO SUBMIT ALL INFORMATION CHANGES to OUAC: university & programme courses in order to be eligible for early admission consideration.
- FEBRUARY 15, 2017 Final grades from Semester 1 courses will be sent to OUAC.
- <u>APRIL 27, 2017</u> <u>2nd semester midterm</u> grades will be sent to OUAC. Universities may make you a conditional offer of admission (dates will vary depending on the university and program).
- <u>MAY 26, 2017</u> the last date by which all Ontario universities must respond to your application. Their response will be 1) an offer of admission, 2) a refusal or 3) a deferral pending receipt of specific information.
- <u>June 1, 2017</u> <u>EARLIEST</u> date by which Ontario universities may require you to respond to an offer of admission. They may also require a **FINANCIAL COMMITMENT** from you (e.g. a registration deposit, residence deposit etc.)
- July 5, 2017 Final grades from Semester 2 courses will be sent to OUAC.
- <u>AUGUST 1-31, 2017</u> <u>Final</u> grades from summer school courses will be sent to OUAC.
 TDSB does this for you automatically. If you are attending a non-TDSB school, you must request them to do this for you.
