RE: EQAO Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics

The Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics will be administered at Agincourt CI on **Thursday, June 16, 2016** from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. All academic and applied Grade 9 math students in Ontario must write this assessment. EQAO is a mandatory part of the Grade 9 math curriculum, and this provincial assessment counts for 10% of students final math mark (in the summative portion of their mark).

This assessment will cover material from the entire school year. Questions are related to a strand and category of math curriculum. Each course level (academic and applied) will write an EQAO assessment designed to reflect their respective math curriculum expectations. The test is structured into two 60-minute booklets. Students will complete the following:
