<u>MONDAY</u> October 16 - December 4

DISCOVERY LAB Grades JK – SK Cost: \$120 + HST

The "Little Fingers Music Keyboard Jam" is a fun introduction to keyboard playing for young musicians and learners. Keyboard Jams are a fun and interactive way to learn the fundamentals of keyboard playing and music theory through the use of SongGames and hand percussion. GOALS OF

COURSE:

Students will learn to recognize the seven letters of the musical alphabet. Students will learn hand position on the keyboard, and the first five notes in the treble clef.

Students will learn how to clap and count short rhythms featuring 1/4 notes, 1/2 notes and whole notes.

Students will learn to play short pieces on the keyboard with the first five notes of the treble clef.

CLAPBOARD KIDS FILM WORKSHOPS Grades 1 – 3 Cost: \$140 + HST

Lights! Camera! Action!

Clapboard Kids is a hands-on filmmaking program that teaches students professional filmmaking skills from an award-winning filmmaker. Using the latest technology, students work collaboratively through the stages of filmmaking – from the creation of an original film idea, through to the planning and shooting of their very own short film. During the session, students will have the opportunity to try out a variety of filmmaking roles and skills (i.e. acting, directing, writing, wardrobe, sound, cinematography and editing).

A range of filmmaking techniques will be explored. These include stopmotion animation, claymation, cartooning, basic special effects and live action to help students create their original productions. As part of the class, students will be given an introduction to film editing using the iMovie app. All technical equipment, props, costumes and set pieces are supplied.

At the end of the session, each student will receive a copy of their finished films to share with family and friends, along with filmmaking information and templates to help them plan their next production!
