

## AY JACKSON JAGUARS AT THE WORLD PARTNERSHIP WALK RAISES OVER \$1000.00



On Saturday May 2nd 2015, the AYJ Jaguars team hosted a garage sale to raise money for their upcoming charitable event - the World Partnership Walk. 100% of the funds raised promote people living in developing countries to take charge of their own lives by creating sustainable improvements to their quality of life. The dedicated volunteers arrived at school at 7 am to set up the tables and put the items out for sale.

Staff and students at AY Jackson donated gently used and new items for the garage sale. Books, clothes, children's toys, purses and a few snacks were sold from 9 am to 2 pm. With the volunteer's tireless efforts, we were able to raise \$508. The Canadian Government will triple this amount, making our final total \$1524.



Fast-forward 3 weeks to May 24th when 33 students stepped forward and walked with 10 000 other people to alleviate global poverty at the [World Partnership Walk](#) in Toronto at David Pecaut Square.
