Dear Parent / Guardian:

Parent-Teacher conferences occur twice during the school year, once each semester. Traditionally, these have occurred following the release of mid-term report cards, but we believe that this is too late in the semester to be of maximum benefit to both students and parents. Waiting until a teacher has "enough marks" to calculate a mid-term report is often too late when it comes to rescuing a student's credit or correcting a negative behaviour, attitude, or pattern. Education research is clear: Communication between school and home is extremely important. Every teacher knows that building a strong relationship with a parent at the start of the year can make a difference in a student's academic, behavioural, and social well-being.

To this end, the staff at A.Y. Jackson S.S. will be holding their Parent-Teacher interviews earlier in each semester. While it will be difficult to give a particularly accurate mark at this time, teachers will focus on identifying students' areas of strength and areas for growth, as well as achievement in the learning skills – *Responsibility, Organization, Independent Work, Collaboration, Initiative,* and *Self-Regulation.* Also, examples of assessments will be shared so that parents can better understand their child's achievement in his or her courses. The purpose of Parent-Teacher conferences is to celebrate student successes and make a plan for improvement where improvement is needed.

Parent-Teacher conferences are a vital part of making your child's school experience both positive and successful. We hope that you will join us on these important evenings.
