Improving Access to School Bus Infomation for Toronto Parents

Beginning this year, TDSB parents/guardians with children who are transported by school buses **can now access their children's transportation information online and receive email notifications** if there are any school bus cancellations or delays, thanks to the launch of a new online transportation portal. GPS technology on all buses will be used internally between the bus operators and school boards at first, but this information will eventually be rolled out to all parents – hopefully within the next year or so. The portal is one of several improvements being made to transportation services to ensure an effective start to the 2017/18 school year.

Tackling Overcrowding in Schools - It's time to do something about it!

Last June, I met with Education Minister Mitzie Hunter about the growing concern over overcrowded schools in Willowdale. We discussed sources of funding including Education Development Charges (EDCs) from new residential developments. The Ministry does not support using EDCs to build and expand schools but parents in Willowdale are asking that something be done to address overcrowding, the growing use of portables and the lack of long-term funding for school infrastructure. Minister Hunter has agreed to hold a meeting with Willowdale parents on October 30th, 2017 to provide details about the government's plan for funding. SAVE THE DATE!! The Ministry has NOT confirmed the location or time yet. I will soon inform everyone once a time and location are confirmed.
