#### Principal's Message

We are so pleased that the roof replacement project has been completed. While there were some challenges, the work needed to be done. The completion of this project will set the stage for installation of solar panels on the roof; that work will begin later. Other areas of improvement will include repairing the pathways, the parking lot and portions of the school yard surfaces.

I have been so impressed with the amazing initiative that the students of Bayview have shown. One of our grade 7 students Ruchi S. has entered the 2017 TIFF Kids International Film Festival's Jump Cuts with her movie about perseverance entitled, "SHE". Ruchi's dedication has paid off as she is a finalist for the second year in a role.

A second tremendous initiative was the selling of SLIME for Sick Kids Hospital. This initiative was led by Alida and Parmin who made and sold Slime to support Sick Kids. - \$325.00 Thank you! Spring is the time that schools receive their staffing allocations

based on the projected enrolment provided by the school board. School board staff provides their projections based on the average daily enrolment at the school, mobility patterns, and the population of the surrounding schools. This year the board has granted Bayview a total allocation of 22 teachers. This allocation is subject to change depending on actual enrolment numbers in September. Within this allocation, there are specific requirements that must be followed. These requirements have been discussed by our Staffing Committee and staff, the executive of our School Council and our Superintendent. The approved model for Bayview MS for next year will be as follows:

- 5 Core Classes of Grade 6
- 5 Core Classes of Grade 7
- 5 Core Classes of Grade 8
- 2.5 Teachers to Support Special Education
- 1 Teacher to support English Language Learners
- 3 Teachers to provide Prep. Time Coverage
- 0.5 Teacher for the Library

#### **Toronto's Annual School Cleanup Day**


