Dear Parents/Guardians:

A new school year is upon us, which means it is also time to elect a new Bayview School Council. Please note that our *School Council Elections* are scheduled for Tuesday, September 26th, 7:00pm, in the school library.

The School Council plays an important role for our school community. It is the function of the School Council to serve in an advisory capacity to the Principal, making recommendations to him/her (and to the Board, where appropriate) on any matter in accordance with the Education Act. The purpose of the School Council is, through the active participation of parents, to improve pupil achievement and to enhance the accountability of the education system to parents.

As such and in accordance with the Bayview School Council Constitution and by-laws, it is the obligation of the Council:

- to establish, nurture and support a positive partnership among the parents and guardians, teachers, students, administrators and community;
- to represent and advocate for the full body of parents and guardians, students and teachers in all matters affecting the school, the Board of Education, and the Ontario Ministry of Education and Training;
- to offer opinions, ideas and advice to school administration, Board of Education and Ministry officials;
- to communicate with all parents to ensure full disclosure of all information about meetings, issues, programmes, and so forth;
- to network and liaise with other school councils, and other education institutions and governing bodies;
- to follow the policies & procedures governing school councils as stated within the Education Act of Ontario.

Please find on the next page a Nomination Form for an elected position as a Parent/guardian Member/representative of the Bayview School Council. Please complete this form and return it the school main office prior to the time of the elections if you are interested in nominating yourself or another parent/guardian as a candidate. On September 26th parents will elect 7 Parent Members of the Council from the list of candidates who have submitted nomination forms.

Once the 7 Parent Members of Council are elected, the new Council will then elect the following Executive members – Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, and Treasurer – from its 7 Parent Members. Please note that, if you are interested in being considered for an Executive position, you must first be

nominated and elected to the Council as a Parent Member. (A Parent Member is also referred to as a "Member at Large".)

Please note that the School Council is required to hold a minimum of four meetings per year; as such, we have scheduled 6 meetings on the contingency that it becomes necessary to meet on a more regular basis. We are considering holding our meetings on the third Wednesday of the month. When discerning your participation as an elected representative on the Council, it is important to consider your availability to meet on the set meeting dates. Maintaining a quorum of Parent Members at every meeting is important to ensure the effective and efficient conducting of Council business. Meaningful consultation, sound decisions and good work is often delayed when a quorum cannot be reached. Please take note of these meeting dates when deciding on your participation:

We anticipate meeting 6 times per year Oct. – May and are considering Wednesday Nights @ 7 PM.

We are very excited about the year ahead and the many opportunities we can build on together with our parent community. We look forward to working closely with all parents/guardians to ensure another successful school year for our students and the entire school community.
