## **Enrichment Budget Update and Vote**

We have two pieces of information in regards to the Enrichment Budget. First is follow-up to the Outdoor Garden, where our continued discussion with the TDSB and Evergreen Brickworks adjusted their cost from \$3,500 to \$13,000. There was no change in the scope and no explanation provided to the change. We feel the significant cost outweighs the value of the project and will be removing it from our budget. We invite parents who feel strongly about this project to make a proposal in the 2019/2020 budget, in November 2019.

Second, continuing from the success of the Empower Reading Program Junior edition (grades 1 to 6), we are proposing H&S allocate \$5,000 to an Intermediate version (grades 7 and 8). This is will not be an additional to the \$38,765 Enrichment Budget, but rather a re-allocation of the outdoor garden (\$3,500) and the promethean board excess funds (\$1,885). The remaining \$385 will go back into the H&S account. We are very proud to have this program in our school and to see the impact it has made on our students' abilities, motivation and confidence. At the April 10<sup>th</sup> H&S General Meeting, we will ask H&S members to vote on the allocation of \$5,000 for an Intermediate Empower Reading Program, providing funds to train staff, purchase materials and implement the program specific to this grade division.
