## Indigo "Adopt a School" Fundraising

It's that time of year again! This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> year in a row that Blake has joined this successful fundraising venture to put more up-to-date books in our library. In the 2015 school year we raised \$4,000 through the online campaign all on our own. Last year we were adopted by one of the largest stores in Canada – the Eaton Centre location – and \$14,000 was raised for our school! This year we were

fortunate to be adopted again, this time by the Coles Beaches store – their goal is to raise \$6,000 for us, and combined with our regular \$4,000 that we're usually able to do on our own, we're hoping for another \$10,000 for our library! For every 2 books you donate online (\$20), Indigo will give us another (to a maximum of 100 extra books). You can also share a story about why books and/or our library are so important to you. We can have a maximum of 20 additional books for those stories, and

we're currently sitting at 5. You can also buy books at the Coles Store in the Beaches (2169 Queen Street East at Lee) and make a direct cash donation. Finally, be sure to look at our Indigo page and 'like' one of the stories that were shared. The top 5 'liked' schools will earn additional funds from Indigo you can only vote once for one story, so choose wisely! Currently we're in 8th place! 5 days into the campaign we're at \$1,000! # We Believe in Miracles : Terry Fox Walk at Blake / EAST

On Wednesday, September 27th, 2017, Blake and EAST students celebrated the legacy of the Canadian hero Terry Fox. We held a kick off assembly in the gym and learned that Terry Fox was only 19 years old when he was diagnosed with cancer. Students also learned that Terry ran an average of 42 km a day, from Newfoundland to Thunder Bay, ON, which is about 170 KM Club laps! After listening to a French song called "Terry Fox: La Perserverance" by Gregg LaRock, Ms. Nicole led an energetic warm-up and then students were off to walk/run around the neighourhood and the school yard for our annual Terry Fox Walk.

Thank you to all of the volunteers who made this incredible event possible. And, congratulations to all Blake and EAST students in adding our loonies and toonies to the more than 700 million dollars that have been raised for cancer research to date in Terry's name.

As Terry said in 1979 "I'm not a dreamer, and I'm not saying this will initiate any kind of definitive answer or cure to cancer, but I believe in miracles. I have to."
