- 1. Round table: All
 - a. Introductions.
- 2. Principal's Report: Nick Tran
 - a. <u>Musical:</u> Excerpts of this year's Musical, Aladdin. 6 students did duets for the parents. Sounded great. All is going well for the production. Details include the following:
 - i. Dates for shows, June 18 and 19, 2 per day, 2 matinees, 2 evenings;
 - ii. Waiting for confirmation at Silverthorn;
 - iii. Will need help from parents to move the sets over to Silverthorn on the 13th;
 - iv. Doing chocolate fundraiser to raise funds for the musical;
 - 1. Chocolates are peanut free; samplers provided at meeting;
 - 2. Permission/responsibility form going home on March 28th;
 - 3. 30 boxes at \$3 each, \$90;
 - 4. Can return funds for sold chocolates and unsold chocolates;
 - 5. Some prizes available but not dependent on who sells the most; Boxes will go home starting Monday the 31st; ends at Easter.
 - b. <u>Staffing</u>: Projection down to 324 students, thus BMS will be losing one staff position. But due to last year's reorganization, it means two staff positions. Ms Toperczer is leaving due to a promotion as a vice principal in the Halton Region. Congratulations to her and we will miss her dearly.
 - i. Grade 6s: 94;
 - ii. Grade 7s: 101;
 - iii. Grade 8s: 106;
 - iv. Numbers above include 11 HSP students.
 - v. Only two realistic staffing models:
 - 1. Model 1:
 - a. 3 classes of grade 6s, at 31/32 students per class;
 - b. 3 classes of grade 7s, at 30/31 students per class;
 - c. 1 class of grade 7 / grade 8 split, at 30/31 students per class;
 - d. 3 classes of grade 8s, at 30/31 students per class.
 - 2. Model 2:
 - a. 3 classes of grade 6s, at 31/32 students per class;
 - b. 3 classes of grade 7s, at 34 students per class;
 - c. 4 classes of grade 8s, at 26 students per class.

Need a meeting with parents to discuss which staffing models. School Council proposed the discussion happen at this time. All present agreed. Overall vote was for model 2.
