OFFICE REMINDERS



Here are a few tips that will help our office staff ensure that students are safe and that attendance is accurately recorded in our system:

- Please report any student absences or late arrivals on a daily basis by calling into our Safe Arrival Line at 416-393-9650 and press 1 to leave a message.
- Late Students must come through the office to sign in and receive a late slip to present to their teacher.
- Early pickups must come through the office to sign the student out.
- Students who need to leave at any time throughout the day should have a written note from their parent/guardian to expedite the process.
- Students should refrain from texting or calling their parent/guardian with their cell phone during school hours, and instead make any necessary calls from the office. This is to ensure the office is aware of any issues that may require a student to leave the premises.
- Any extended absences, vacations, etc. should be documented in a note to the office, and a copy to the teacher

STUDENT SAFETY COMES FIRST

Bowmore Public School takes the safety of our students seriously. It's because of this that we have a secure access system installed at our main entry that gives our school staff more control over who enters our school. This means that when you arrive at our school the outside doors will be locked and a buzzer system will need to be used to gain access to the school. Using this system will provide a safe and welcoming environment and a single point of entry where visitors will be welcomed and directed to the main office.

In addition, this week we have had both the Fire Marshall and Toronto Police Services conduct walkthroughs to ensure that every part of our building is safe and secure. We know that you are entrusting us with the wellbeing of your children, and we will continue to work hard to ensure that your trust is well placed.






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QSP Fundraiser

Police Background Check Information: Mandatory for Volunteers

Police background checks are now mandatory for anyone over the age of 18 who volunteers in TDSB schools or is in contact with students more than three times in a school year. This includes parents volunteering for School Council organized events, field trips, special events, etc. The police background check is a three step process:

1. Complete and submit the police background check form and payment. Individual applications can be obtained and submitted through the school office. This is a one-time application but takes several months to process. Individual applicants must submit payment using a bank draft or certified cheque for \$20. (See below for batch submission process)

2. Register your results with TDSB

When your application is processed, the Toronto Police Services will mail you a letter with your results. Take this to the school main office and they forward it to the central TDSB office to be entered into the system. It will be returned to you in about two weeks. If you want verification that this has been entered in the system, wait until it is returned and ask the main office to check the list.

3. Renew your application within one year

No more than one year after your background check has been approved you must submit a free annual renewal form in order to keep volunteering. This renewal form must be completed annually or your background clearance will expire and you will have to go back to step 1.

Take Part in the Batch Application Process: Available Until October 27

In order to make this process easier, the Bowmore School Council will collect applications and the \$20 fee from individual parents and submit the applications as a batch on your behalf (meaning you don't have to go get a certified cheque). We will be submitting a batch of applications on October 27, 2015.

If you would like to participate in the BSC's batch application for background checks please: 1. Pick up a Police Check form from the Bowmore office and complete it. 2. Drop it off with payment (\$20 cash or cheque to Bowmore School Council) at the Bowmore office before October 27. You can leave it with Krista Baines or in the Bowmore School Council mailbox.

Please see our website, **BowmoreSC.com** for our "cheat sheet" with important notes for filling out the form. Note that it must be filled out completely and correctly or it will be rejected.
