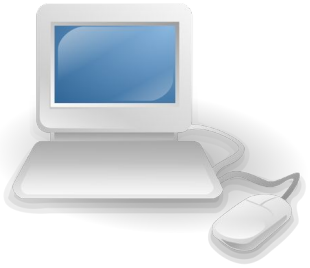

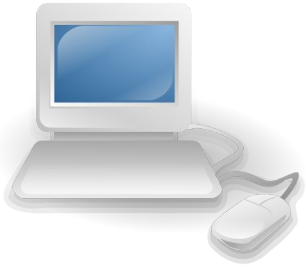

Application Timelines

January 9, 2023 - Secondary Out-of-Area Admissions Online application **opens**

January 27, 2023 (4:00 p.m.) - Secondary Out-of-Area Admissions Online application **closes**



Out-of-Area Admission

- Families may select up to two (2) schools and must rank their choices.
 - ***If the student is selected for their first choice, they will not be considered for their second choice.***
- The selection process is random, all email communication and responses are managed centrally
- Families will be contacted via email.
- ***Please do not contact schools directly for results or updates.***

Acceptances Timelines

February 8, 2023 - Acceptances and waitlist status will be sent centrally, via email to all applicants. **Offers expire February 14, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.**

February 15, 2023 - Second round of Acceptances and waitlist status will be sent centrally, via email to all applicants. **Offers expire February 21, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.**

February 22, 2023 - Any final offers will be sent. All waitlists expire on this date. **Offers Expire on February 24, 2023.**

February 27, 2023 - TDSB students must finalize their acceptance by completing and submitting the corresponding course selection for the accepted school in myBlueprint

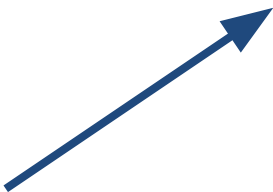

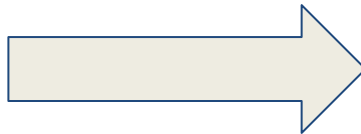

 - If your student is accepted into their first choice program, they will not be considered for their second choice
- Applications cannot be changed after they are submitted. Please ensure your application is submitted no later than ***Friday, November 25 at 4:00 p.m.***

Acceptances: Timelines

The random selection process will occur centrally and all communication will come from the Board. Please do not contact schools directly for selection results.

- **December 8, 2022** - Acceptances and waitlist status will be sent centrally, via email to all applicants. **Offers expire December 14, 2022 at 4:00 p.m.**
- **December 15, 2022** - Second round of Acceptances and waitlist status will be sent centrally, via email to all applicants. **Offers expire December 21, 2022 at 4:00 p.m.**
- **February 22, 2023** - Late offers will be made should spaces become available up until this date (Secondary).
