Chair's Update:

1. Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC)

• TDSB has held Town Hall meetings on Special Education Inclusion. There is a plan to hold a consultation for the SEAC members in the New Year.

Action items:

- Ask parents to bring forward any special education issues
- o Betty Garnett will send out an invite to parents.
- SEAC established a working group to explore collaboration with Parent Involvement Advisory Committee (PIAC) on special education. PIAC's purpose is to support, encourage and enhance parent engagement in order to improve student achievement and well being.

2. 2012 School Statement of Needs (SSON)

- As a result of the parent survey conducted at the October 16 meeting, the following top
 6 priorities have been identified:
 - 1. Parent engagement through innovative ways
 - 2. Support for highly valued range of unique programs
 - 3. Visible school administration
 - 4. Support for students in achieving t heir full potential
 - 5. Support and positive change for students with special needs within the school
 - 6. Transparency with School Council

3. Breakfast Appreciation for Teachers

• Consensus: postponed to a later date when labour disputes resolve

4. Chair's conversation with Trustee Harout Manougian

The chair shared the essence of the update he had from the Trustee, including:

- the Board's discussion on severing school land in North York, Scarborough, and Etobicoke to raise funds to address capital's challenges.
- the labour relations, which ongoing update can be found on the Board website
- Trustee's inviation to attend School Council meeting in January

5. Feedback on Parent/Teacher Interviews

- The following concerns were identified by parents who were present:
 - Some parents were not able to get interviews with all their child/ren's teachers
 - o 10 minute time limit seemed insufficient for some parents
 - Principal clarified:
 - All teachers are available by phone/email
 - Contact the VP or the school office to obtain a teacher's phone number or email address
 - Administration will look at ways of accommodating families beyond first-come-first-serve. Asking parents to provide feedback on whether or not a window of time during the day, i.e. 2-4 p.m. would be feasible

7. Parent Involvement Conference

- Generally well attended, successful event, delivered on November 17 at Earl Haig SS
