

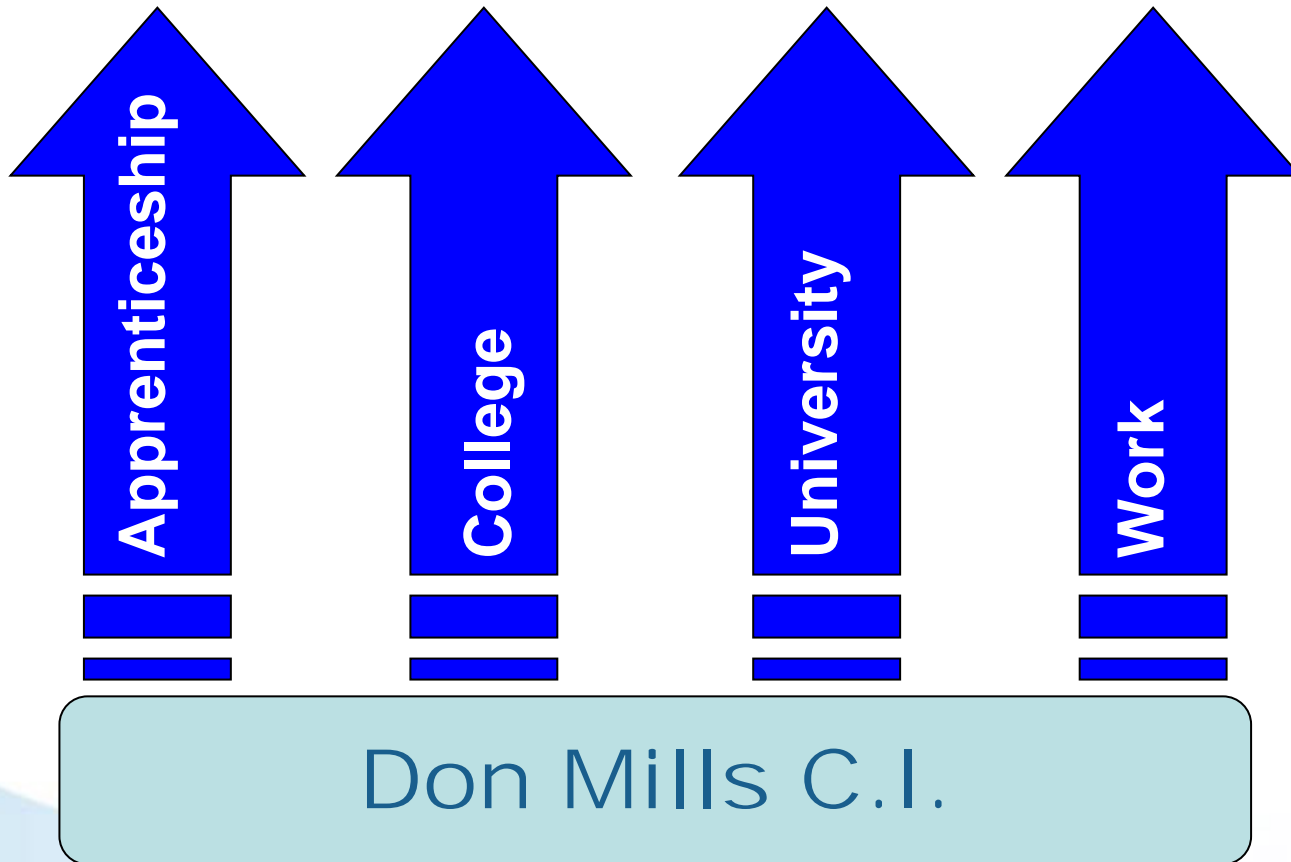

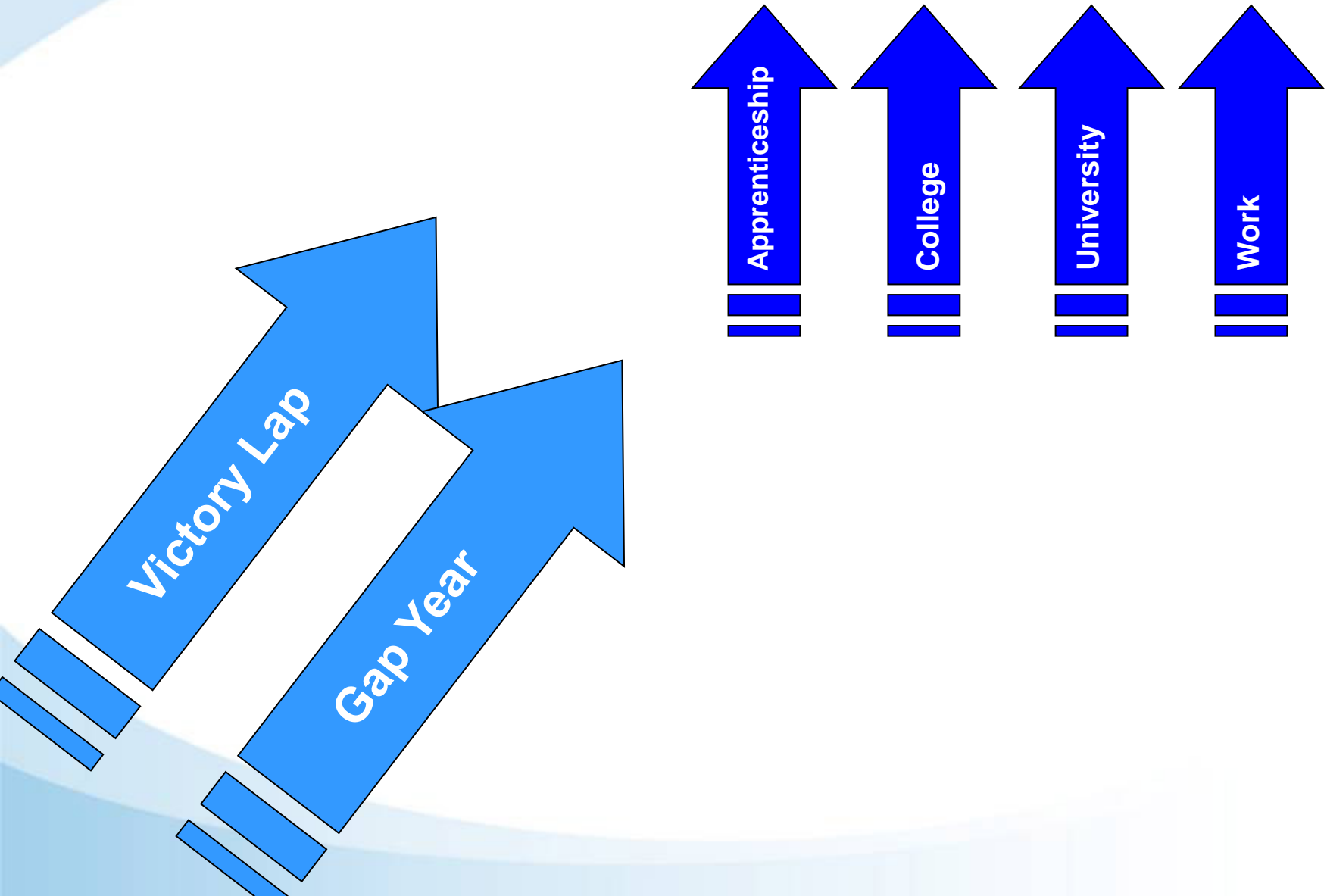

# College Eligibility

## *Requirements*

- ***High school diploma including...  
Gr.12 English, College or Univ. level***

***AND depending on the program, there may be:***

- ***additional criteria for admission***
- ***prerequisite courses***
- ***English/Math assessment***
- ***minimum grades***
- ***interview, portfolio, etc. for competitive programs***
