

#### **Police Involvement**

- #Uttering a threat to inflict serious **bodily** harm on another person;
- **#Possessing alcohol or illegal drugs**;
- **#**Committing an act of **vandalism** that causes extensive damage to school property at the student's school; or
- **#**Hate motivated violence
- $\mathbf{HExtortion}$ .

## Mandatory Suspensions / Possible Expulsion

- **Responsible** Possessing a weapon, including possessing a firearm;
- **#Using a weapon** to cause or to threaten bodily harm to another person;
- **Committing physical assault** on another person that causes bodily harm requiring treatment by a medical practitioner;
- **#Committing sexual assault**;
- **XTrafficking** in weapons or illegal drugs;
- **#Committing robbery**;
- #Giving alcohol to a minor; or
- **#Possession of an explosive substance**

#### **Code of Conduct Applies**

- **#On school premises**
- \*\*On field trips and any activities that are part of the school program
- #On school bus or any vehicle under contract to the board
- #Off school premises where conduct has impact on safety, security, or physical & mental wellbeing of any member of school community





#### **Headgear Policy**




- #Each school must establish a dress code.
