The minimum no. of years required at ...



The minimum number of years required to waive requirements for an English facility test is <u>four years</u> of satisfactory full-time study in an English-language school system in a country where the <u>dominant language is English</u>.

If an English facility test is required, students will be exempt from also having to include a 4U English (ENG4U) in their admission average, provided that six other acceptable 4U credits are presented.

Minimum TOEFL Score	100 total iBT with 22 on Writing (discretionary range 89-99, provided at least 19 on Writing is obtained)
	250 total CBT with 5.0 on Essay (discretionary range 230-247, provided at least 4.5 on Essay is obtained)
	600 total PBT with 5.0 on TWE (discretionary range 573-597, provided at least 4.5 on TWE is obtained)
Minimum MELAB Score	85 overall with no part score below 80 (discretionary range 80-84, provided no part score is below 80)






