### **January 15, 2014:**

Latest date to submit completed online applications to the OUAC...for equal consideration

### **February 4, 2014:**

Recommended last day to make changes to your application for equal consideration

### **May 29, 2014:**

Date by which the universities must respond to your application for admission.

### **June 2, 2014:**

Earliest date by which the universities may require a response to offers of admission and a financial commitment.

# The minimum no. of years required at ...



The minimum number of years required to waive requirements for an English facility test is **four years** of satisfactory full-time study in an English-language school system in a country where the **dominant language is English**.

If an English facility test is required, students will be exempt from also having to include a 4U English (ENG4U) in their admission average, provided that six other acceptable 4U credits are presented.

<b>Minimum TOEFL Score</b>	100 total iBT with 22 on Writing (discretionary range 89-99, provided at least 19 on Writing is obtained) 250 total CBT with 5.0 on Essay (discretionary range 230-247, provided at least 4.5 on Essay is obtained) 600 total PBT with 5.0 on TWE (discretionary range 573-597, provided at least 4.5 on TWE is obtained)
<b>Minimum MELAB Score</b>	85 overall with no part score below 80 (discretionary range 80-84, provided no part score is below 80)

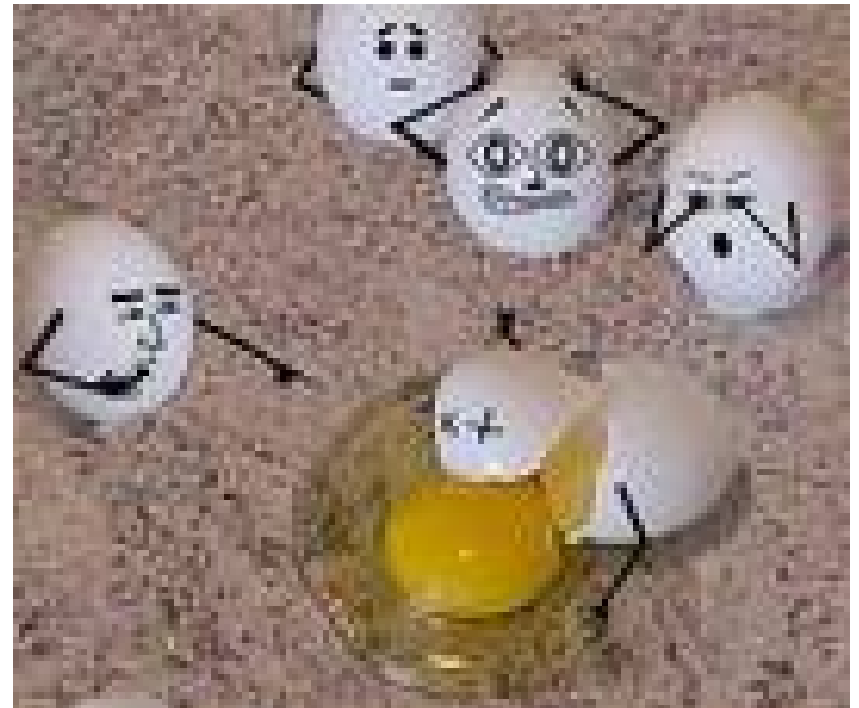
