Important Dates For University Applicants

Ontario University Application Center (OUAC)

January 15, 2014: Deadline for you to submit completed applications to the OUAC.

Note: In order to be in the first round of consideration for university, you **MUST** respect deadlines. Late applications will be considered in a second or third round.

February 4, 2014: Last date to submit all information to OUAC (Including Program changes) for early admission consideration. Changes will be accepted and processed by the OUAC at any time.

February 13, 2014: Deadline for the OUAC to receive all final first-semester grades.

April 24, 2014: Deadline for schools to report midterm grades for second-semester.

May 29, 2014: The latest date you can expect a response from an Ontario university. The response will be one of the following:

- 1) an offer of admission;
- 2) a refusal; or
- 3) a deferral pending the receipt of specific additional information.

June 2, 2014: The earliest date by which Universities may require a response to an offer of admission and a financial commitment of any kind (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.) All other admissions-related elements including scholarships, other forms of student assistance or financial incentives, and offers of residence are considered part of the offer of admission.

Important Dates for College Applicants

Important Dates For College Applicants

Ontario Colleges Application Center (OCAS)

November 25, 2013: Applications to college programs opens. This is the earliest date that colleges may acknowledge applications.

*February 1, 2014: Equal Consideration Date

Apply before this date in order to receive equal consideration for admission to programs starting the following fall. After this date, colleges consider applicants on a first-come, first-served basis until programs are full.

Note: applications to <u>Highly Competitive Programs</u> must be received by this date in order to be considered. As these programs receive a high volume of applicants, all seats may be filled by February 1.

Students are encouraged to complete their applications well before the Equal Consideration Date, as website volumes on the online application are at their highest at this time.

Many programs continue to accept applicants after February 1.

*February 1, 2014: Earliest Offer Date

This is the earliest date that colleges may send offers of admission for the upcoming academic year. Offers will continue to be issued until programs are filled or wait-lists are established.

May 1, 2014: Deadline to Confirm Offers of Admission

Applicants must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission by this date. Log in to your account to <u>confirm your offer</u>. Colleges may extend offers of admission after this date. Each college has it's own deadline.

June 16, 2014: Earliest Tuition Due Date

The earliest that colleges may require payment of tuition fees is mid-June. Each college sets its own deadline for payment of tuition. This date will be communicated to you by the college.
