CAMP WAHANOWIN BEHAVIOUR CONTRACT

1) All school rules are to be followed including dress code. All students are expected to be on time for all activities.

2) All instructions given by Teachers or Camp Counsellors are expected to be followed at all times. Arguing and/or ignoring instructions on an overnight trip are a safety issue, and will be subject to discipline if it happens repeatedly.

3) Cell phones are NOT to be brought to Camp. Part of the Camp experience is to be "off the grid". The primary contact will be the School – Ms. Shea – 416-393-9455.

Any other communication must go through the main phone number of the Camp - <u>Tel: 705-325-2285</u> <u>Fax: 705-327-7120</u> and the contacts will be one of the Duke of Connaught Teachers: Ms. Oliveira, our Vice-Principals Mr. Gambacort and Ms. Helpert. Any cell phones brought will be removed for the duration of the trip.

4) iPods, Mp3 players etc. are not recommended to be brought to Camp. If, however, a student chooses to bring one along, they are to use it only on the buses or in their cabin. Neither the Camp nor the School will be responsible for lost or stolen property.

5) All students are expected to respect Camp property and leave things exactly as they find them. Any property damage (i.e. windows, doors, toilets etc.) will be assessed to the parents of the student(s) involved.

6) No student is allowed to enter any cabin except the one assigned to them. If a student is found in a cabin of the opposite sex at any time, parents will have to arrange to have their son/daughter picked up that same day.
