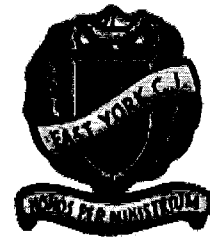

GRADUATION PROM PROCEDURES AND EXPECTATIONS

Students eligible to purchase tickets must:

- Be a member of the graduating class of 2016-2017 at East York C.I. as determined by Administration.
- Be the guest of a student who is a member of the graduating class of 2016-2017 at East York C.I.

Prior to arrival at the Prom:

1. Graduating students must present their receipt of purchase in order to receive their invitation.
2. Graduating students may bring only one guest. The host must accompany their guest to the Prom venue.
3. Graduating students (and their guests) must sign up in advance for a specific table and a meal; no table switches will be permitted at the Prom Venue.

Arrival at the Prom:

1. Upon arrival at the Prom, students will sign in at the Reception Table.
Photos / Reception: Starts at 5:00 pm
Seating: Starts at 7:00 pm
Dinner: 7:15 pm
2. No admittance after 7:00 pm.
3. Balloons will be part of the décor at the prom. It is the responsibility of the students who have allergies towards latex balloons, to notify Ms. Plagianakos before they purchase their ticket on **May 12, 2017**. Accommodations may be made.

Prior to purchasing a ticket, you will be asked to review applicable Terms & Conditions.

- We will not be responsible for any tickets that are lost or stolen
- This ticket **cannot** be, transferred, exchanged or refunded

- Unlawful resale (or attempted resale) of a ticket is grounds for seizure without refund
- Security searches will be conducted upon entry to the event to ensure the safety of all attendees
- All applicable TDSB/EYCI policy & corresponding authority apply to this school-sanctioned event
- Adherence to EYCI/TDSB **Codes of Conduct** will be strictly enforced

- Use of Drugs/Alcohol will result in ejection, notification of parents and suspension
- Unacceptable behaviour likely to cause damage/nuisance or injury will result in ejection
- The unauthorized use of photographic and recording equipment is prohibited.
- No commercial filming, recording or photography of any kind in any media is permitted without duly authorized permission from the Toronto District School Board
- Effort to admit latecomers will be made, but admission will not always be guaranteed
- There will be no pass-outs (in/out privileges) or re-admissions of any kind
- Students are responsible for securing/arranging and paying for transportation to and from the event
- **Violation of the Terms** - You understand and accept that if you break any of the terms and conditions outlined herein, we reserve the right to refuse admission (or eject as the case may be). Refunds will not be issued.
