Registration for September 2017 will be starting on Tuesday, February 7, 2017. Please call our office to book an appointment. We will be scheduling appointments between 10:00 am - 11:30 am and from 1:30 pm - 3:00 pm.

Children who were born in 2013, turning 4 years old by the end of this year are eligible for enrolment in Junior Kindergarten for September 2017.


Children who were born in 2012, turning 5 years old by the end of this year are eligible for enrolment in Senior Kindergarten for September 2017.
