Junior Extended French which begins in Grade 4 **Middle Immersion** which begins in Grade 4 (limited number of schools)


The application process opens *November 1, 2016* and the deadline for applications is **December 1, 2016**.

This is a message from the crossing guard who is located at Bayview Avenue and Bayview Mews Lane.








Please inform your children of the rules to make sure that they dismount their bicycles, skate boards, scooters and hoverboards when they are crossing the street.

9 Days of Giving

November 21 - December 1, 2016

Elkhorn students, staff, and parents are, working together to help needy people in our community and supporting the North York Harvest Food Bank by organizing a food and clothing drive called the Nine Days of Giving.

Each day from Monday November 21 through to Thursday December 1, students are encouraged to bring an item to school from our list below which are very useful for the homeless and families in need. Thank you for your support!

The items will be collected over **nine days** as follows:

- 1. Monday November 21: Baby food/formula
- 2. Tuesday, November 22: Macaroni and cheese, pasta, rice
- 3. Wednesday, November 23: Canned fish or meat salmon, tuna or ham
- Thursday, November 24: Canned soup or vegetable
- 5. Friday, November 25: Cereal or granola bars
- Monday, November 28: Fruit (dried or canned), or iuice
- 7. Tuesday, November 29: Canned beans
- 8. Wednesday, November 30: Shampoo or soap
- 9. Thursday, December 1: Gently used clothing (children or adults)
