IMPORTANT NOTES – JANUARY FORMAL EXAMS 2017

- NOTES: 1. Each student is responsible for reading his/her timetable carefully and for arriving at each examination 10 minutes prior to the start time.
 - 2. Textbooks will be collected before the exam begins. For each exam being written, students must bring their textbook to the exam room.
 - 3. All students with two exams at the same time must speak to Ms. Greeley immediately, if they haven't already done so.
 - 4. A student who arrives late for an examination will report directly to the exam room and will write in the time remaining for that exam. A student who arrives after an examination has been written will not be permitted to write the examination and will be assigned a mark of zero.
 - 5. If a student is unable to report for an examination, the Main Office must be notified promptly (416-394-7840). A student who is absent from an examination for medical reasons must submit a medical certificate from a physician to the Attendance Office by Tuesday, January 31st at the latest. Also if there are verifiable compassionate grounds for a missed exam, such as a death in the immediate family, please inform Ms. Greeley.
 - 6. All articles not necessary for writing the exam should be left in your locker.
 - 7. You must bring pens, pencils, erasers and math instruments to the exam. Only non-programmable calculators will be permitted, when specified. Cell phones are not permitted. Sharing of calculators will not be allowed. Foolscap and graph paper will be provided by the school.
 - 8. If a student is caught cheating during an examination, the student will be removed from the examination room and will receive a mark of zero on the examination. Parents of students under 18 years of age will be notified. Circumstances may warrant further action.
 - 9. No cell phones, MP3's, IPODS or any form of electronics are to be used during exams.
 - 10. At the end of the exam, students must leave quietly and quickly. Others may still be writing. Please leave the school as soon as possible. Students may not leave for the first hour of any exam.

No cafeteria service during Exam Days.

The halls should be clear at all times except when you go to your locker at the beginning and end of your exam.
