Library Revitalization

In the next few weeks, the Library collection will go through a revitalization. Materials will be removed from circulation based on specific criteria, including the current relevance of the content, the potential bias that might exist in the material, the visual and physical format, the condition of the materials and the connection with the current curriculum. Although not all learning resources will meet all the criteria listed below, teacher-librarians exercise professional expertise, judgment, and sensitivity in applying the criteria when choosing resources.

Removed materials are recycled. Materials that are no longer suitable for Forest Hill CI students are considered unsuitable for all students. Ms. Haines, the ACL of Library and School Wide Initiatives, has already been purchasing new resources, based on identified areas of need and has been working closely with staff and students to acquire meaningful books that are in demand and will get into the hands of our students.
