This report card is part of the Ministry of Education's policy on Assessment, Evaluation and Reporting in Ontario Schools, Grades 1 – 12. Your child's *Elementary Progress Report Card* informs you of the progress he or she is making at this point in the school year. The second page provides a report on your child's overall progress towards the achievement of curriculum expectations. Your child's teacher(s) will check one of the following to indicate his/her progress:

The reporting process consists of two parts, receiving a report card and an interview with your child's classroom teacher/core teacher. Interviews are very important, as they are a chance for us to share information on your child's progress.
