We expect Harrison students to be good citizens by showing the following behaviour:

- *I use polite language when speaking e.g., please, thank you, etc.*
- *I listen attentively*
- *I wait my turn*

I show kindness through my words and actions.

- *I keep my hands and my feet to myself*
- *I do not play-fight*
- *I play safely and fairly*
- *I am a buddy not a bully*

I solve problems peacefully in person and/or on the computer.

- *I listen without interrupting*
- *I control my tone of voice*
- *I cooperate to find a solution*

I show respect for the environment.

- *I help tidy up my class*
- *I keep the washrooms clean*
- *I look after my belongings*
- *I treat school property and materials with care*
- *I care for the trees in the yard and I use the garbage, recycling and green bins*



CONSEQUENCES FOR BEHAVIOUR

Staff may impose any of the following progressive consequences as necessary:

1. warning
2. temporary removal from the class or a timeout on the playground
3. loss of recess
4. letter or call to parent/guardian
5. written behaviour contract
6. replace or pay for lost or damaged property
7. withdrawal of privileges
8. TDSB formal suspension in keeping with board policy
