Student Pick Up and Drop Off

We would like to bring to your attention to the traffic signs posted on Trehorne Drive and Tallon Road.

There are <u>No Stopping</u> and <u>No Parking</u> signs.

Their purpose is to prevent potential traffic hazards at school drop-off and pick-up times.

The SOUTH SIDE of Trehorne Drive and the EAST SIDE of Tallon Road are the DESIGNATED DROP-OFF and PICK- UP SPOTS. Parents should not be stopping or parking for more than 5 minutes when dropping off or picking up their child.

The traffic signs on the **NORTH SIDE** of Trehorne Drive and the **WEST SIDE** of Tallon Road is <u>No Stopping.</u>

Anyone contravening these signs will be ticketed.
