Class Reorganization

Each spring the planning department provides the school with projections for the coming school year. In the fall, schools and the staffing department review class sizes and determine if it is necessary for schools to reorganize when classes are too large or too small. This year, our two English Kindergartens were below projected so we will be going down to one class, and we were given a teacher for J/I French Immersion to reduce class sizes. We are working with our staffing department to reorganize the French Immersion classes to create lower class sizes. We are expecting to be able to provide information to students and families about changes next week. During this time, it is extremely important to be supportive and to trust your children to be able to adjust to new learning situations.

Curriculum Night

Curriculum Night will be held in-person on Wednesday, October 4th from 6:00-7:30 pm. Curriculum Night is an opportunity for families to connect with the teachers and staff here at Humbercrest. Curriculum Night offers a chance to learn about the programming that is in place to support students as well as an opportunity to build connections between staff and families.

Families are encouraged to reach out to staff throughout the school year as the home-school connection is vital for the ongoing success of students. More specific information will be shared next week.

Student Assemblies

On Thursday, we had divisional assemblies with our students encouraging them to be leaders in our school. It was reinforced that all students represent the Humbercrest community both during the day and after school hours, and that we all have a duty of care towards students, staff and community members. Based on some of our observations and conversations with students, we wanted to provide a few important reminders about creating a safe environment for all. Here are some of the points we raised:

- Keep hands and feet to yourself at all times
- No rough play during sports or games
- Respecting the personal space of peers
- After school, using the field appropriately, and be aware of your surroundings when engaging with peers (e.g., no running on the roads, using respectful language)

We are hoping for your support to continue this messaging at home; the home and school partnership is critical to ensuring the safety and success of all Humbercrest students.

Photo Day

Photo day is coming up on Monday, October 2nd. If your child is absent, there is a retake day scheduled for Thursday, November 9th. This will be for individual photos only. Class photos will be scheduled later in the school year.

Orange Shirt Day

September 30th is Orange Shirt Day, it also marks National Day of Truth and Reconciliation Established in 2013, Orange Shirt Day was inspired by Phyllis Webstad, who was excited to wear her new orange shirt to her first day of school in 1973. However, when she arrived at St. Joseph Mission Residential School, her shirt was taken and never returned. From that day forward, the colour orange, for Phyllis, reminded her of that moment, how her feelings didn't matter, how she felt like she wasn't worth anything and that no one cared for the children who were crying about it that day.



Now, on this day, we recognize the legacy and impact of the residential schools system on First Nations, Métis and Inuit families and communities.

We acknowledge the legacy of residential schools in Canada by wearing orange and we honour the survivors. We remember the thousands of children who were murdered and buried in unmarked graves. With September 30th falling on a Saturday, the TDSB will wear orange on Friday, September 29th.
