FLL- First Lego League

This is the third year that our school is taking part in the FIRST Lego League Competition. What is the FIRST Lego League? The FIRST Lego League challenge consists of three component parts -Core Values, Robotics, and an Inquiry-based Project. This challenge exposes students to realworld engineering challenges by building LEGObased robots to complete tasks on a thematic playing surface. Students are also presented with a real world challenge that they need to solve, helping them develop important skills for their future. While preparing and participating, students are expected to demonstrate values such as cooperation and an enthusiasm for learning new things and persevering. This is consistent with TDSB's vision that our students develop Global Competencies that will help them in their future endeavours.

This year's team consists of students from grades 6 to 8 who have some experience with Lego Mindstorms Robotics, and have demonstrated a strong work ethic. There are 10 students on the team who will compete at the qualifying event. We are also proud to have a group of 5 students working and learning with us this year.

The coaches and teacher mentors this year consist of Josie Nanfara-Grande, Renu Mann, Lukrica Prugo and Mandi Campos. We are also fortunate to have 2 youth mentors from our original team supporting us - Emily Moore and Mahek Kaur, Humberwood Alumni.

Robotics: Students program an autonomous robot to score points on a themed playing field (Robot Game). Missions require the robot to navigate, capture, transport, or deliver objects on a printed mat (the Field).

Project: The team develops a solution to a problem they have identified. This year's theme is Hydro Dynamics, and students are challenged to

• Identify a problem within the human water cycle;

• Design a solution that makes this problem better;

• Share their problem and solution with others.

Core Values: Students are expected to conduct themselves according to the guidelines set by the FLL, which encourage teamwork, gracious professionalism, and cooperation above all things. Our official qualifying tournament is on Saturday, December 16th at John Polanyi CI.
