# **Parents/Guardians of Children in Grade Three**

You have a choice to make about French programming for your child. Grade 4 is the <u>ONLY</u> time your child can begin a Middle French Immersion program.

#### Middle French Immersion Grade 4 and 5

- all classroom subjects are taught in French (Language, Math, Social Studies, Science, The Arts)
- no English Language Arts instruction (Specialist subjects may be offered in English)

### Grade 6

-all classroom subjects are taught in French and one hour of English is added.

In Grades 7 and 8 the students blend in the same class as the students who are in the immersion program from Senior Kindergarten.

### Grades 7 and 8

- half of the day is in French and half of the day is in English. The subjects taught in French are Language, History/Geography, Math and The Arts.
- All other subjects are taught in English.

Offers of placement will be on-going through the weeks and months following the close of the application period.

## **IMPORTANT DATES:**

Applicants who have older siblings currently enrolled in the program and who will be in attendance the following year have a priority placement in that school. Every effort will be made to accommodate all students interested in Middle French Immersion but that is not always possible. If there are more applicants than available spaces, a waitlist will be maintained until the last day of school in September of 2017.

Classes with fewer than 25 students may not open.
