## Computer Use

- Lakeshore Photo I.D. Card is required for computer use.
- Observe the School Board's Code of Ethics and Acceptable Usage Guidelines for Internet Use (no games, downloading or chat)
- Use of Internet and/or e-mail without a clearly defined educational purpose is not permitted.
- Food and/or drinks are not permitted in the library.
- User ID's are assigned to each student for their personal use. Unauthorized use of someone else's ID will result in consequences as determined by the school administration.

## **Lunch Period**

- Students are invited to enjoy their lunches in the cafeteria only. Food may not be consumed in the hallways, stairwells, classrooms, library, auditorium or gyms.
- Students are expected to leave eating areas in good condition, litter free.

## Posters

- All posters must be approved / initialled by a vice-principal.
- Event organizers are responsible for removing posters after the event.

## Lost and found/Valuables/Lockers

- All students are required to have a locker. Lockers are the property of the school and are maintained and provided to students by the Vice Principal for their convenience to store belongings. Students are advised not to bring valuable or expensive items to school or to leave them in the lockers.
- Lockers may not be shared.
- Books and clothing may be brought to and picked up in the Lost and Found area in the Main Office.
- The TDSB does not carry insurance covering loss of personal items from lockers or elsewhere on school property. Students are fully responsible for all personal property brought to the school building or grounds. School staff does not assume any liability for damaged, lost or stolen items.
- Protect yourself against loss/theft of personal property.
- Do not bring more money to school than is absolutely necessary.
- Do not leave valuables in the change room or another locker.
- Make sure that your name is on your books, gym equipment and personal property.
- Do not reveal your lock combination to anyone.
