2. This test is mandatory for all **Grade 9 Pre-AP, Gifted, Academic and Applied students**. Lists of students who are scheduled to write this test will be **posted in front of the main office**. Students should also **speak to their math teacher for details and ask for extra help if needed**. Please note that students are *expected to know* which room they are writing in and be at school at **8:30 a.m. sharp**.

3. Please ensure that your child is **well-rested and has a healthy** breakfast that morning. Please note that students will be provided with a drink and light snack during their break.

What <u>NOT</u> to Bring	What <u>TO</u> Bring
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No personal belongings (i.e. personal electronic devices, backpacks, pencil cases, purses, hats, coats, etc.) are allowed in the examination room. All such items must be left in lockers or at home. All writing instruments must be in <i>plain view</i> on the student's desk. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students should bring pencils, erasers, a scientific or graphing calculator and a ruler. A highlighter may be helpful

4. The Grade 9 EQAO Math Test will begin exactly at the *designated time*. Students who are late for this test must **sign in the main office** and will be allowed to write for the **balance of the time** remaining only.

5. Also, we are asking parents/guardians to please **reschedule any appointment(s)** for their children that day so students can complete this important assessment which will count for **10% of each student's final mark** in the course.
