#### **TUTORING INFORMATION:**

The TDSB continues to support students with unfinished learning through the Ministry's funding for Tutoring programs until March 31, 2023. Tutoring may be accessed in schools, communities, and online. We encourage principals and vice-principals to speak with teachers who may be interested in beginning or expanding tutoring programs. All tutoring services are voluntary. There is no obligation for any student to participate in tutoring.

TDSB students have free, unlimited online tutoring available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week through <u>Paper</u> and <u>Brainfuse</u>. The TDSB is not operating online tutoring services. This means that TDSB staff will not be present

during tutoring sessions.

Parents/Guardians/Caregivers and/or Students (18 years or older) who wish to participate in one of these free online tutoring services should contact the company directly to learn more about their services and the registration process.
