But at Selwyn, staff are continuing to work on inquiry plans to move their students forward in the areas of numeracy and literacy. As part of our school improvement plans, staff are using success criteria ahead of an assigned task and then use teacher or peer descriptive feedback on tasks in order for students to improve their work. Students will be working towards the intended *learning goals* [where am I going?] and using the success criteria [how am I doing?] as they continuously strive to do better than their best. You will hear and read this vocabulary as your child moves through Selwyn and onto middle school.

The students of the We Club have been working to inform and engage the students and staff of Selwyn about those less fortunate as us locally and globally. We collected over 250 food items for the Daily Bread Food Bank in our We Scare Hunger campaign. We are now embarking on our We Create Change campaign to help build schools for children in developing nations. Our Spirit Days this year will be our main fundraising events from Crazy Head Day to our upcoming Candy Gram and Backwards Day. All contributions are voluntary but are also very appreciated.

As the cold wind and threat of snow slowly creeps upon us, please ensure that your child is coming to school prepared with the appropriate clothing.
