

Free Dental Care

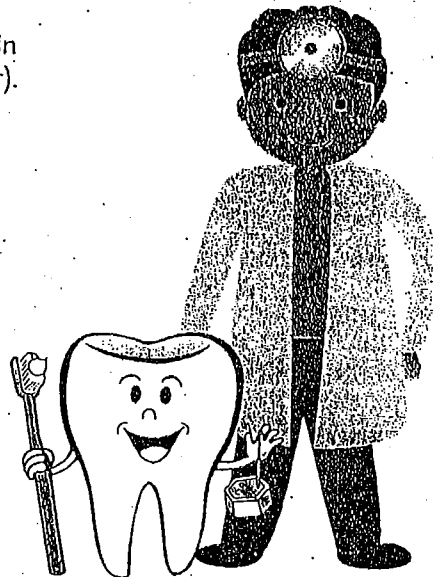
Our dental services are offered to children (0-17 years), parents enrolled in selected Toronto Public Health programs and seniors (65 years and older).

To be eligible:

- You must live in Toronto
- You cannot have dental insurance
- You are not able to pay for a dentist

Services Include:

- Examinations
- Fillings
- Root canal treatment on selected teeth
- Extractions
- Partial and full dentures – a fee may be required for dentures
- Prevention and education
- Fluoride treatment
- Cleanings
- Sealants
