


# A NOTE FROM TOM:

## This Year's Holiday Charitable Program Begins December 4th!!

With the help of Principal Rzepa, Whitney will have the opportunity to provide support and cheer to 7 families who need a little help over the holiday season. Class Parents will be distributing details of our needs on Monday, Dec 4th. Meanwhile here's an overview of the program:

The Abundance program provides support to families who need a little help over the holiday season. TDSB Social workers help to identify families who are in need in our schools across the city. Schools are given an opportunity to offer assistance and support.

This year, each grade at Whitney will support one family. You will be able to sign up to purchase an item from the list identified by the Social Workers and families receiving the support. No one is required to participate and no families should feel obligated to take part.

Class Parents will be assisting to create Google docs/worksheets to allow easy access to the lists and ability to sign up for certain items. Over the next two weeks, we will be collecting specific clothing items, food gift cards, and other wish list items. New items are requested and please send receipts in with these items/gift cards in case exchanges are necessary or a card is not able to be activated. Please wrap the gifts, if you are able. All items will be dropped off to the TDSB Social Workers and they will coordinate the delivery to each family.

This month and next month, the Character Traits we are focussing on are Empathy and Kindness and Caring, respectively. This is a wonderful opportunity for us to model these traits during this holiday season and give our students an opportunity to help others.

#### Whitney Parent Council December 2017 Spending Vote

Please be advised that a general meeting of the Whitney Parent Council (the "Council") has been called for **Tuesday, December 19th, 2017 in the Whitney Jr PS staff room at 5p**. A motion will be proposed with respect to spending a portion of the excess funds the Council currently as in its bank account.

Parents and teachers are invited to vote in person or to send in a vote by proxy (appended).

#### **Current Financial Position**

Historically, Whitney has started each school year with at least 100% of funding in place for the budget at hand. We are in the position of having excess funds above what is required to fund the remainder of the Council's 2017/2018 operating costs.

Surplus Funds available for special spend \$17,868 (Oct 31st)

#### **Technology Resource Request (Motion)**

Principal Rzepa initiated a consultative process with the Council and parents during the November General Council Meeting and outlined the following:

Whitney Jr PS currently has 30 Chrome books and a charging cart which is used primarily by the Grade 4 class to support many students with needs. We would like the other Grade 5 and 6 classes (and possibly the French classes) to have access to this more often. These 25 chrome books would support all three Junior classes (including Room 304, the new Grade 5 class which does not have a lot of technology). We are hoping to purchase these this year.

The Whitney Parent Council (the "Council") has amassed funds in excess of what is required to fund their annual budget (the "Excess"); The Excess currently amounts to \$17.868 (Oct 31st);

## Girls Basketball (Travel Team)


