EQAO results for Whitney P.S. 2013-2014 are now available at <u>eqao.com</u>. To view our primary and junior results, type in Whitney P.S. (postal code M4T 1C7).

An initial analysis of our overall grade 3 and 6 school results indicates that our students continue to perform WELL ABOVE both the TDSB and provincial standards. In grade 3, our students made significant gains in reading, writing and mathematics where 100% of our students scored at level 3 or 4 in reading and writing!! In grade 6, our students continue to score at or above provincial standards – at or above 90% in all three areas of the curriculum (above provincial standards).

Individual student reports will be sent home and or mailed within the next few weeks. School staff will meet to review the detailed report to schools and determine areas of need, actions and strategies to incorporate into our school improvement plan.

Volunteering at Whitney?

Last year, the TDSB stated that any parents/ guardians who wish to volunteer at a TDSB school are required to obtain a validated police check. In the spring 2014, we asked all parents who were interested in volunteering for the 2014-2015 school year to complete the attached form and return it to the school office with a cheque for \$15.00 written out to Whitney Public School. Many thanks to the over 110 parents who completed this form!!

Below is a reminder of the steps involved in completing the entire process and having your name added to our approved volunteer list.

Step 1 Fill out a police reference check form (see attached) and bring it to the school office with your personal cheque of \$15.00.

Step 2 You will receive (at your home) your original validated police check.

Step 3 Bring your original validated police check that you have received in the mail to the school office ASAP. (Many parents have not done this step and will not be approved until we get the original from you.)

Step 4 The school will send your original validated police check to the TDSB reference check office for approval.

Step 5 The school office will let you know that your police check has been cleared and you are on the TDSB approved volunteer list.




Library volunteers required!






