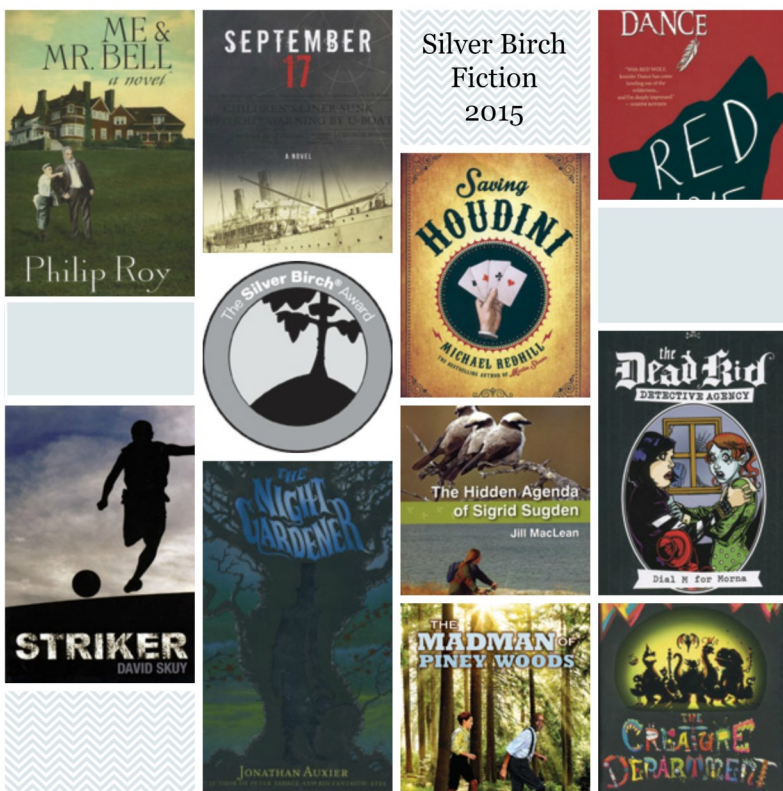


On behalf of the staff, I would like to wish all families in the Whitney community a happy and safe March break! See you back on Monday March 23rd.

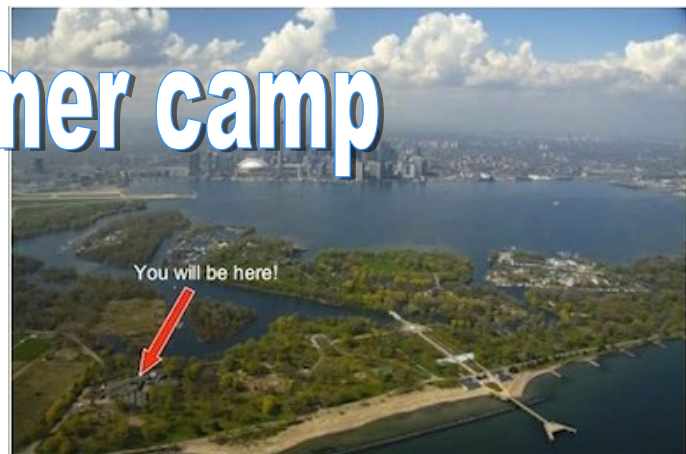
The list of team challenges and dates will be posted outside the Main Office shortly after March Break. Announcements will also be made prior to each challenge.
