3. Financial Update (Lianne)

- Current status of Finances is positive
 - Awaiting the receipts for Grade 5 graduation spends; otherwise, all budgeted funds have been spent
- FUN FAIR profits: approximately \$10,000!!! (waiting for a few final expenses to clear to finalize numbers)
 - Very expensive to run this year as the event was larger but very well received; cost was approximately \$9700
 - Lots of snacks left to sell which will be used at a snack sale (or two!) in June so we can clear them out before the summer break. All profit from these sales as no snacks will need to be purchased.
 - 5 lunches remain and need to be paid for from the account.
 - Lots of discussion around how to spend the profits from the fun fair. Approximately \$8000 to be allocated to spends allowing \$2000-\$3000 to remain in the school council account for September start-up costs.
- Budget requests from Mr. Tran and school staff for 2026-2027 School Year:
 - Sound System replacement \$3000
 - Get To Know You Day (GTKYD) support: \$1100
 - Transportation (Buses): \$3000

- Grade 5 Graduation: \$500
- Welcome to Kindergarten supplies: \$500
- Technology: \$13,500
 - Including Knowledgehook program
 - Purchasing 45 chromebooks- need to replace the grade 4 and 5 computers. The TDSB will no longer be providing 1:1 devices for grade 5 students.
 - 2 Charging carts- approximately \$6000 (\$3000 each)
- Discussion around not being able to approve all based on budget constraints and need to bring these items to a vote with the new council in the fall budget. Graduation and welcome to Kindergarten happen late in the year and can be requested in the fall budget meeting.
