Parents Reaching Out (PRO) Grants for School Councils

The purpose of the Pro Grant: to support initiatives/activities that engage parents/caregivers (virtual), and builds School Councils' capacity around Human Rights, Equity, Anti-Racism, Anti-Indigenous and Anti-Black Racism

- This year the TDSB is focussing on literacy
- Some schools are doing Literacy nights/days with storytelling of different Cultures. This would be done virtually, one days in two months
- One day in the afternoon during school/ one day in the even hours.
 Workshop could be 1 hour.
- The amount is \$1, 500.00 the same as last year. Application to be submitted online, no paper allowed
- School Council Co-Chair(s) will need to apply for the grant. The deadline to apply is December 3rd 2021. A draft of the proposal needs to be sent to our Colleen interim CSW, Mr. Reynolds for review by tomorrow.
- Colleen interim CSW has already emailed a template to the Co-Chair(s)
- Last year AAS apply we did not get the Pro Grant but the school covered the cost of the workshop. We had Mosa McNeilly as the facilitator for the Family Art Night. It was called Black Hair Magic: Healing from Anti-Black Racism.
