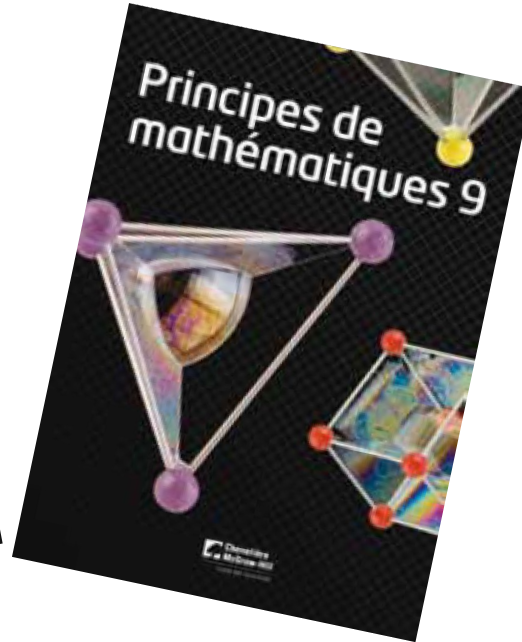
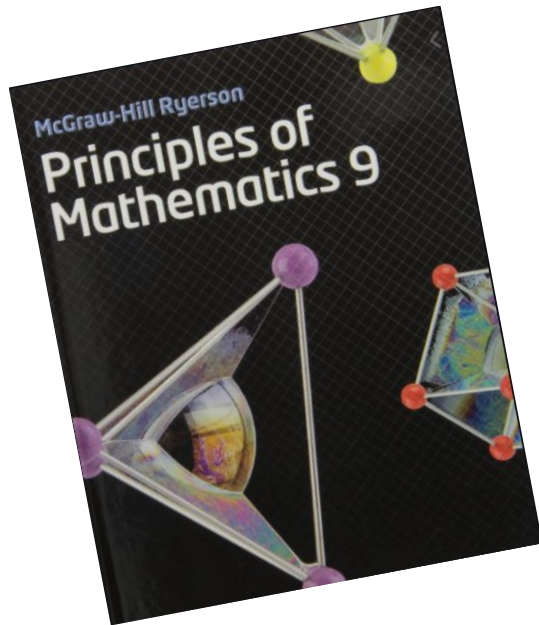

- Financial Literacy

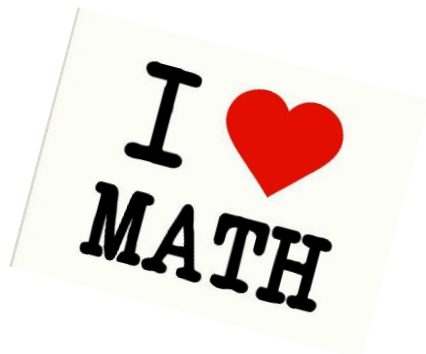
