Welcome to Albert Campbell Collegiate Institute! We offer a solid academic experience to students. Our learning environment is defined by conscientious and respectful students, caring and specialist teachers, and an unwavering respect for close partnership with parents. We are a semestered school which offers grade 9 students the added benefit of managing their transition to high school in a supportive, responsive and structured environment. Students take **four** courses each semester for a total of **eight** courses for the entire year. We set high expectations for our students which allow them to focus on success and build leadership skills through a variety of co-curricular experiences.

At Albert Campbell, we value student voice and choice because we see these as important aspects of student success. We have the structure, experience and commitment to support students entering grade 9 in all the pathways they may choose. All students scheduled to attend Albert Campbell for the 2017/2018 school year are eligible to be considered for our Enriched Grade 9 English, Math and Science courses. Space is limited to 30 students per course. To decide final enrolment, consideration will be given to the grade 8 teachers' recommendation, an information form and attendance at an orientation session <a href="whiteholder whith whith will include a written Math">written Math</a>, Science and English component for interested students to demonstrate level of numeracy, literacy and problem solving skills. This session will be on Friday, January 20, 2017 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. at Albert Campbell C.I. Please see the second page for materials needed for you to be prepared for the written component.

All students who wish to be considered for enriched courses must complete the information form and bring it with them to the orientation session on January 20. The form will be available from your grade 8 guidance counselor.
