## Remember your diploma requirements



OSSD Requirements - Compulsory Credits
$\square 4$ credits in English ( 1 credit per grade)
$\square 3$ credits in Mathematics (1 credit in Grade 11 or 12)
$\square 2$ credits in Science
$\square 1$ credit in Canadian History
$\square 1$ credit in Canadian Geography
$\square 1$ credit in the Arts
$\square 1$ credit in Health and Physical Education
$\square 1$ credit in French as a second language
$\square 0.5$ credit in Career Studies

- 0.5 credit in Civics


## OSSD Requirements

## - Compulsory Credits

$\square$ Group 1 Credit: an additional English credit, or French as a second language*, or a Classical or International language, or a Social Sciences and Humanities credit, or a Canadian and World Studies credit, or a Guidance and Career Education credit, or Cooperative Education credits*
$\square$ Group 2 Credit: a Business Studies credit, or a credit in Health and Physical Education, or a credit in the Arts, or credits in Cooperative Education*, or French as a second language*
$\square$ Group 3 Credit: a Grade 11 or 12 Science credit, or a Technological Education credit, or a Computer Studies credit, or Cooperative Education credits*, or French as a second language*
$\square$ *Note: A maximum of two credits in Cooperative Education and two credits in French can count as compulsory credits.

## OSSD Requirements <br> - Elective credits and more

$\square 12$ optional / elective credits
$\square 40$ hours of community involvement activities
$\square$ The provincial literacy requirement (OSSLT)
$\square$ Note: Students who are not successful on the first attempt are eligible to take the literacy course in their grade 12 year (OLC4O1).

## Pathway Planning

$\square$ Pay attention to admission requirements / prerequisites for post-secondary opportunities
$\square$ Cooperative education?
Dual Credit? SHSM?
$\square$ Variety of learners, including special needs


## Research Before You Choose!

$\square$ Make sure you choose courses thoughtfully!
