OSSD Requirements

Compulsory Credits

- 4 credits in English (1 credit per grade)
- □ 3 credits in Mathematics (1 credit in Grade 11 or 12)
- 2 credits in Science
- 1 credit in Canadian History
- 1 credit in Canadian Geography
- □ 1 credit in the Arts
- 1 credit in Health and Physical Education
- 1 credit in French as a second language
- 0.5 credit in Career Studies
- □ 0.5 credit in Civics

□ PLUS...

OSSD Requirements

Compulsory Credits

- □ **Group 1 Credit:** an additional English credit, or French as a second language*, or a Classical or International language, or a Social Sciences and Humanities credit, or a Canadian and World Studies credit, or a Guidance and Career Education credit, or Cooperative Education credits*
- Group 2 Credit: a Business Studies credit, or a credit in Health and Physical Education, or a credit in the Arts, or credits in Cooperative Education*, or French as a second language*
- Group 3 Credit: a Grade 11 or 12 Science credit, or a Technological Education credit, or a Computer Studies credit, or Cooperative Education credits*, or French as a second language*
- *Note: A maximum of two credits in Cooperative Education and two credits in French can count as compulsory credits.


OSSD Requirements

- Elective credits and more

- □ 12 optional / elective credits
- 40 hours of community involvement activities
- □ The provincial literacy requirement (OSSLT)
 - Note: Students who are not successful on the first attempt are eligible to take the literacy course in their grade 12 year (OLC4O1).

Pathway Planning

- Pay attention to admission requirements /
 prerequisites for post-secondary opportunities
- Cooperative education?
 Dual Credit? SHSM?
- Variety of learners, including special needs


