- Ask questions!



Requirements

What Do I Need to Graduate?

- 30 Credits (18 compulsory, 12 elective)
- Successful completion of the OSSLT or OLC4O1 course
- 40 Community Hours

 Visit the Ministry of Education <u>Website</u>



Important!!!

- Grade 12 students who have four courses per semester and wish to drop one due to extenuating circumstances should be aware of full disclosure dates!
- 5 days after mid-term report card issued
 - SEM 1: November 23, 2016
 - SEM 2: May 3, 2017
 - Course(s) <u>dropped before</u> these dates <u>will not</u>
 appear on your Ontario Student Transcript

Heading to University?

- Know the pre-requisite courses required to apply for your program(s)
- Keep your options open!
- General requirements:
 - Six 4U/M courses at the Grade 12 level
- Application Fees:
 - \$150 for three program choices
 - \$50 for each additional choice
- Applications due: Wednesday, January 11, 2017

Heading to College?

- Know the pre-requisite courses required to apply for your program(s)
- Keep your options open
- General requirements:
 - C/M/U courses; some at the Grade 12 level
- Application Fees:
 - \$95 for five program choices
- Applications due: Wednesday, February 1, 2017 (equal consideration date)

Financial Assistance

- Personal Savings
- Consider a part-time job
- Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP)

 - Apply after you accept a program




