Dear Albion Heights Parents/Guardians

We have just received some important updated information from Toronto Public Health.

As Toronto is now in Lockdown schools and school communities must continue to stay diligent. Toronto Public Health has updated the student screening tool. The changes include a new requirement that **if a student has even one symptom on the screening tool, they must stay home, self isolate and get tested at an Assessment center. In addition their siblings and other children in the household need to self isolate.**

**Public health measures to keep your family and community safe**

- Check on vulnerable family members, friends and neighbours.
- Download the COVID Alert App so you can be notified if you come into contact with someone who is contagious with COVID-19.
