In School Learning Returns

TDSB Parent Letter

The TDSB sent out a parent letter this evening addressed to those families who requested a switch. Please read this letter carefully for important information. Switching Between In-Person Learning and Virtual Learning

Virtual to In-School Learning

If your child is returning back to school learning after the survey that you filled out between Dec. 18 to Jan. 4 and has been approved by the board, you would have received a call letting you know what class your child is in. Your child's teacher will be reaching out to you. Students are to meet in the back of the school where they will line up with their class. The teacher will come out and check that the health screening has been completed. Students must wear a mask.

New TPH Screening Tool for Students

One of the most important things we can do to slow the spread of COVID-19 in our school is for students to screen themselves daily for any symptoms of COVID-19 and also follow the circumstances in which they should stay home. TPH recommends students and their household members who have even one mild symptom of COVID-19 get tested.

TPH has revised its screening tool for students effective immediately. Both the TDSB student health pass and the TDSB App have been updated with this change. Mask Wearing

Given the new direction that masks should be worn when physical distancing is not possible, we will be directing students to wear their masks at recess and at lunch. Teachers will be providing built in mask breaks during the day. Please send your child with a few masks that can be worn during the day.

Lunch

While students have their masks off during lunch, this is a quiet time. Students are sitting in their desks eating quietly.

If students are able to eat lunch at home, then please do so. Please let your child's teacher

know if you can.

Pick up and Drop Off

We are asking that parents and guardians are diligent about physical distancing at pick up and drop off time. Masks are required for all parents and guardians while on school property. All students must have their mask on as they arrive on school property and head for their line up area. Once you have brought your child to their line please say goodbye and step away from the line.

No Congregating

Please remember that parents and students are not to congregate in the school yard, and outside of school.

Visitors

We are limiting the number of visitors to the school. Please call the school if you have a question.

Winter Dressing

Children will be outdoors frequently so please ensure that they are dressed for the weather including cold days with extra layers, mittens, hats and scarves.

Clean Fanny Packs

Students who have switched back to in school learning will receive a fanny pack to carry their masks in. Students who were in school between September to December already have one. Please continue to use it.

Borrowed Devices

If you borrowed a device(s) for the on-line learning period please hold onto them for now. We will be collecting them at a later date.
