In grade 1/2/3 PE, we have been learning how we can create a more equitable gym environment through positive motivation and supporting each other through activities. We have discussed and shared examples of what it looks like to help each other when someone might be struggling with an activity. At the end of the week, the students were asked to share an example of how they encouraged or helped someone else in their class to help them succeed.

We have also been learning how to use choice to achieve success. The students have been learning fitness circuits with many different exercises and stretches at different levels of difficulty. The students are learning how to self select their level of difficulty and complete the exercises that they are comfortable with. This way everyone feels that they have accomplished their fitness circuit.
