Student Placement for the 2022-2023 School Year

The process of student placement is a collaborative one that has input from sending and receiving teachers, the Principal, special education teacher, ESL teacher and support staff (where appropriate).

Before the end of the current school year, several meetings will occur that are devoted to student placement. During these meetings, the best possible educational experience for your child will be kept in mind. Parent information shared throughout the year and at Parent-Teacher interviews will be used as the teachers discuss student placement and consider the following:

- balance of numbers in a class
- Ministry of Education Kindergarten and Primary class caps
- social, emotional and physical needs
- academic needs
- consideration of sibling placement(s)
- ratio of males to females

If there is information about your child that you feel should be considered during these placement meetings, please submit it in writing to Mr. Sanyal by Friday, May 13, 2022. Your information should indicate your child's needs as opposed to names of teachers. Any requests for specific teachers cannot be considered as changes to the 2022-2023 staff, teachers and grades are ongoing and can continue until September.
